Studio Space Rental

As a not-for-profit corporation, Gananoque Arts Network (GAN) is focused on transforming our community and lives through the power of creative expression. GAN offers affordable studio rental spaces for visual artists to create & exhibit work. Studio spaces are available on a first come, first served basis**. We are committed to maintaining a friendly and inspiring working environment while simultaneously providing opportunities for artists to engage with the public. Studio renters are encouraged to maintain regular studio hours throughout their lease agreement, although GAN recognizes that this arrangement may not suit everyone's needs.

All GAN studios share a creative production space located at 167 King Street East Gananoque. The space has been divided to facilitate 5 studios, each measuring approximately 10 x 12 ft with 10 ft ceilings, open to the shared public gallery. A clean-up area with sinks is in the building as well. Gender neutral washrooms are located within the GAN space and are also shared with the Cafe. The space is not a lock-up facility, but the building is locked during off hours and renters are provided with a key for access. Electric power outlets are available for each space and there is general lighting. Some restrictions are in place; for example, open flame is prohibited.

The Noel Bullock gallery space is available to GAN Creative & Artist Insiders to exhibit their work. Studio artists may participate in these exhibitions at no additional charge. Private rentals may also be accommodated for short term workshops or small events at a reduced fee to studio renters. Rental rates are determined by the Board of Directors annually. Rental fees are inclusive of tax, internet and utilities. A minimum 2 month commitment is required. GAN can offer additional insurance to studio renters for a nominal fee on an as needed basis.
